~ Quilt Show Ribbons ~


Please bring a sample of the ribbon you would like for us to make for the Quilt Show to the January meeting. We will be making a decision at that time. Make it simple!

The author has designed needlework patterns for twenty years and enjoyed a variety of creative endeavors. This is a book of seasonal embroidery designs that can be used to make fun whimsical gifts such as the Happy Spring Napkins, Busy As A Bee Pincushion, Fall Fun Doorknob Hanger, and Smiling Snowman Towel. Michael starts with the basics of machine embroidery and provides instructions for the use of different threads and embellishments.
