Library Report: I have enjoyed looking at Kaleidoscope ABCs by Marti Michell. What is a Kaleidoscope Block? We can see curves and circles in Kaleidoscope designs, when all of the seams are straight lines. There are 14 beautiful Kaleidoscope patterns included in this book, and a From Marti Michell Kaleido-Ruler is required for making each of the projects. A sample of the ruler is included at the back of the book. Marti assures us that when using the Kaleido-Ruler, all you need to know is the finished block size, no tricky math formulas are required. These probably would not be projects for the beginning quilter, but

the intermediate quilter will find that the challenge yields a beautiful (and intriguing) quilt. Thanks to Linda Adkins for donating this book to our library. If you would like to CHECK IT OUT, let me know.


