Border Lines, Book 1, 2, & 3, by Pam Clarke, is simply a sketchbook of border line sketches. The designs included in this book are helpful and timesaving to the quilter, whether the quilting will be done by a long-arm, mid-arm, home sewing machine, or by hand. I believe quilters will appreciate the time and effort that Clarke has given to drawing out over 60 designs, showing the direction in which each one is to be stitched.
