~ Meeting Minutes ~ August 15, 2022

<u>5:30 Workshop</u> - Make mine Hot Chocolate – Pat Wade. Pattern for cup was provided with instructions for 3 sizes (wall hanging, table topper, and throw). Cutting instructions for use of a 6" square are provided. The B1 in the 6" square instruction is the same size as B, but allows for directional fabric.

6" block exchange – Set up in the front room, 22 squares needed 2 folks have dropped out.

<u>Guild Meeting Minutes</u> - The 2022 August meeting was held at 5:30 pm at Calvary Baptist Church. Sondra Curtis called the meeting to order with 33 members and 3 visitors in attendance.

<u>Minutes from prior meeting</u> - Minutes were distributed last month with the newsletter. They are approved as written.

Saturday Workshops – August 20 – Sandy Morris Bag for Beads of Courage – Arkansas Children's Hospital gives patients glass beads of courage for each procedure that is done. There is a program for making bags for these beads, kits come with 50 labels and bag instructions. The bags need 2 pieces of coordinating fabric large enough for 2 -

9" X 12" outside, 2-9"x12" inside, and 2-26" cord. More information can be found at Beadsofcourage.org. Plan to come 8/20 to the church, 9:30 am, bring fabric, sewing machine and supplies and we will see how many bags we can make! Sack lunch. If you have fabric appropriate for children, please bring it.

October 1 - Pat Wade - Raw Edge Applique – Class will teach how to raw edge applique a wall hanging with 3 Santas for Christmas decorating. The cost of the class is \$5 and Pat will provide kits for the applique pieces for \$5. You will need to provide your own background fabric 22" X 19" and some scraps to practice on. Since this project will require a lot of pressing, if you have small iron and board you may want to bring. Sack lunch. Let Pat know if you intend to participate as she will not cut up fabric for your kit unless you commit. Signup will be done at the Sept. meeting, supply list will be provided in the newsletter.

Program – Jane Bell from The Stitchin' Post of Little Rock - A slide presentation about English Paper Piecing (EPP) history and modern methods was presented. The Stitchin' Post set up a pop-up shop of various items and EPP kits. While it is primarily hand work, modern methods do encourage using glue rather than basting each piece. A class will be hosted by the Stitchin' Post on August 30th, 1 pm – 4 pm to help anyone who purchases a kit get started.

Their displays included samples of the Lucy Boston's Patchwork of the Crosses blocks made using the kits available for purchase. Absolutely beautiful blocks with amazing fussy cut detail.
