SCQG BOM – Cheri Johnson - Each month a BOM is selected, members are asked to make blocks. At the next meeting, everyone brings their blocks and turns them for the drawing. One block = 1 ticket. Out of the tickets, 1 person is the lucky winner of all the blocks. This month's winner is Judy Anderson, winning 22 Yin Yang blocks. Next month's block is a Christmas stocking, pattern provided. Ola displayed her stockings Christmas quilt.

**Donation Quilt** – Jane Hammonds (absent) Pat Wade - Donation quilt was raffled off at Old Fashion Day, 10/15/2022. The winning ticket was Shelly Morton a local resident who bought her ticket that day. We need to look at the ticket sales from this donation quilt and determine if, when, and how we plan to do future donation quilts.

**Prior Donation Quilts:** 

- 2018 generated \$1,578; cost \$221
- 2019 generated \$1,939, cost (top was donated), \$75
- 2022 generated \$1,619, cost \$105.

Jane has more information about the ticket sales. Discussion about quilt every other year and what the bylaws define. Motion made and passed to table discussion until all tickets sale information and bylaws research could be completed.

**Door Prizes** - Cely Slover conducted door prize activities.

#### **Old Business**

**Old Fashion Day Booth 10/15/2022** – Old Fashion Day was well attended, good ticket sales. Local resident won quilt, bought ticket that day. Expect OFD to be held again next year. Have some ideas
