- March Auffle Fund Raiser Barbie Small Her prior quilt guild had an annual combination auction/raffle, they called an Auffle. Everyone brought sewing related items that they did not want. These items were grouped and then tickets were sold at \$1 each. Individuals could then bid on the items using their tickets. It was always a fun activity and generated money for their guild. We will try it out in March 2023, Barbie will be the organizer for the activity. Everyone start collecting their "auffles" to donate.

SCQG BOM – Cheri Johnson - There were 36 Christmas Stocking blocks donated this month and the BOM group voted to divide them into 3 groups of 12 and draw for 3 winners. The winners are: Norma Welch, Barbara Keys, and Shirley Miller. The BOM will continue into 2023, until the 12 blocks necessary for a quilt have been made. Friendship Star is next month's BOM. (BOM participation details: Each month a BOM is selected, members are asked to make blocks. At the next meeting, everyone brings their blocks and turns them for the drawing. One block = 1 ticket. Out of the tickets, 1 person is the lucky winner of all the blocks.)

#### **Old & Unfinished Business**

Name tags – if you want a magnetic name tag, they are \$9 each and will be shipped directly to you from the vendor. Vendor information is provided in the newsletter each month. Please wear a name tag to help us all learn each other's name.

**SCQG Directory** – Still collecting and making pictures for the directory. Directory will be paper only, so this will not be on the internet. Estimated cost for directory will be less than \$5.

**Donation Quilt** — Jane Hammonds/Pat Wade – Donation quilt was raffled off at Old Fashion Day, 10/15/2022. The winning ticket was Shelly Morton a local resident who bought her ticket that day. We need to look at the ticket sales from this donation quilt and determine if, when, and how we plan to do future donation quilts.

Prior Donation Quilts:

- 2018 generated \$1,578; cost \$221
- 2019 generated \$1,939; cost top was donated, \$75
- 2022 generated \$1,699; cost \$105

Discussion about quilt every other year and what the bylaws define. Motion made and passed to table discussion until all tickets sale information and bylaws research could be completed.

This discussion is going to remain tabled until the January 2023 meeting where the bylaws will be reviewed. There are several items in the bylaws that need revision, such as the requirement and management of a library which we voted to discontinue earlier this year.
