**JULY PROGRAM**  
**PAPER BAG PROJECT**

At the July meeting we will have Paper Bag Project. It is hoped that we will have good participation.

The idea is to make an item for someone with items they place in a paper bag. It can be a small wall quilt special block, pincushion, needle case, small bag or a tea cozy. There are usually ideas in quilt magazines for small items. Use your imagination.

Items for the Paper Bag Project include 3 fat quarters (18 x 22 inches) plus any trims, sequins, beads, buttons, rick rack, lace or ribbon that you might want used on the project. If you have something extra that you want to use, you can do this, also. You **MUST USE** some or all of the fabric in the paper bag.

Write your name on a piece of paper and put it in the bag. Please don't tell anyone whose bag you have. Don't take any items from the bag until you get home so others cannot tell whose bag you have.

Bring the finished project to the August meeting at which time you will present the finished project to the person whose name was inside the bag, plus all leftover fabric and any notions.
