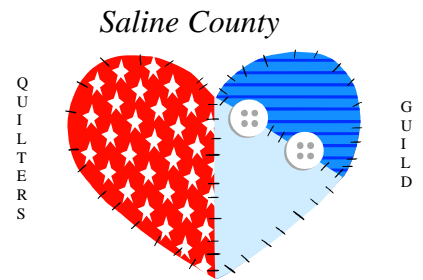

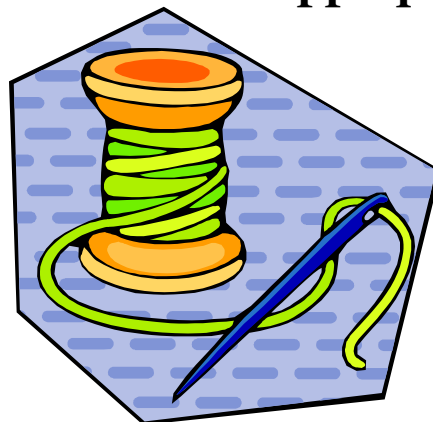

We hope you have had time this month to think about your Snowbound Quilt and where you are going with it and how you want it to look.

In our August Meeting we will talk more about getting our tops put together and our quilts quilted and finished.

Bring your Show and Tell so we will know how far along you are. We hope you are all getting your blocks ready to be put together and if you need help, we can be there for you.

In September, JoAnn will talk to you and show you how she bound her quilt before it was quilted. Parts of her quilt is fastened together with different embroidery stitches. We will bring our quilts and show you what we have done to finish ours with buttonhole and other stitches.

Try to spend a little time each day working on your top and before you know it, you will have a new fall quilt that you will be proud of.

JoAnn likes to use the fusible batting when she gets ready to put her quilt together.

Lemon Bars (submitted by Gwen Rogers)

1 pkg. lemon cake mix

1/3 c. veg. oil

1 egg

Mix together until crumbly. Reserve 1 cup of mixture. Set aside. Spread remainder of crumbs in a 9X13 pan. Pat down. Bake 15 min. at 350.

While that is baking, prepare the filling:

8 oz. pkg. cream cheese

1 Tbsp fresh lemon juice

1 egg

1 cup sugar

Whip til fluffy. (Mine wasn't fluffy) Spread over baked crust. Crumble reserved cup of crumbs over top. Return to oven. Bake 25 min at 350.

Toothpick inserted in center should come out clean.

<http://quiltingpassion.com> Be sure and check out the tutorials. The one on flying geese is great. I really enjoyed the site and think all of you will too.

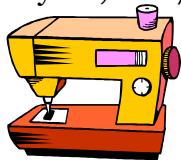
Continue to remember in your thoughts and prayers our members and their families who are going through difficult times. Also remember to practice random acts of kindness each day.
