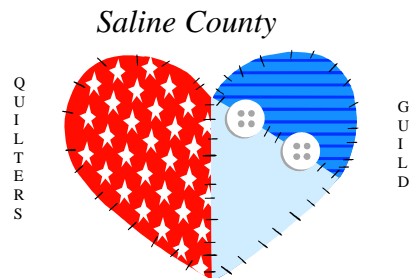

Take Exit #117 - Cross over I-30

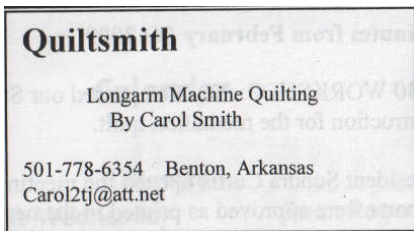
