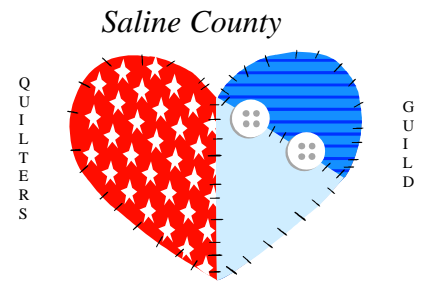

Jane Hammonds is still in need for volunteers to lead a Saturday workshop, so if you would like to offer your experience, please give Jane a call!

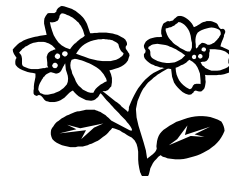

We will continue the pillowcase challenge until Dec 2010.

Please help by donating finished pillowcases or fabric.

Instructions for a basic pillowcase are on our web site or you can find them at the web sites listed below. I will have my serger at QA meetings on the first Monday of each month, so please join us. If you are donating fabric, please have it precut to the correct sizes. You can give it to me or leave it at Pinwheel fabrics. For each pillowcase cut: 27" x 42" for main body, 11" x 42" for cuff, Optional: 2 1/2" x 42" for accent strip. These pillowcases will be added to the national count and given to *local Charities*. So we will be helping our community. If you know if a charity that could use pillowcases let me know. Also if you would like to help with the donation of the finished pillowcases, please give me a call.

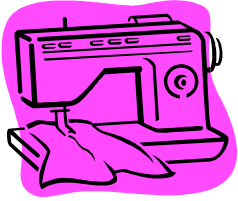
