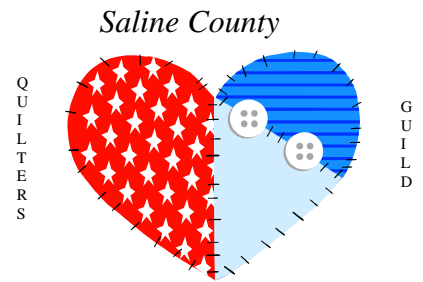

Take Exit #117 - Cross over I-30
At first stoplight, turn right on to Market Street. Travel through three stoplights. FBC is on the right at the intersection of Market and River Streets. Turn right on River Street. The Family Life Center entrance is on the left at the second circle drive. The parking lot is across the street.

FROM TEXARKANA ON I-30 East

Take Exit #117 - Bear to the right

Jean Corley's Chowder Recipe Jan 2010

Chicken Corn Chowder

2 chicken breast halves (cooked and cut into pieces)

Save the broth.

I use about 2 1/2 cups of broth: Add 1 lb. pkg. frozen mixed vegetables

2 cups diced potatoes

1/4 Cup chopped onions

Cook until vegetables are done.

Add 1 (17 oz.) can creamed corn and 1 (8 oz) jar Cheese Whiz

Add more broth if too thick.
