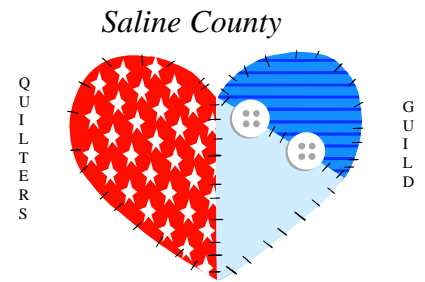

**April program and workshops:
 SNOWBOUND CLASS**

Sondra said 23 people have signed up for this class and we are so excited! When you arrive, you will be directed to the area where we will meet.

Snowbound quilts (finished and UFO's) will be there for you to look at. We will pass out a rough outline of things to be demonstrated throughout the project. It will not be cast in concrete, so it can be changed to suit one's needs and wants.

At this first meeting, our plans are to demonstrate the SNOWMAN for appliqué. You will want to make several of these for your quilt. The other demo will be curved landscape background for some of your blocks.

Please bring white on white or suitable snowmen fabric, fabric for hat and scarf. We will have poster board and plastic template for spray starch patterns ---- freezer paper for needle turn appliqué. Bring landscape background fabric ----- sky -- nighttime and stars or tree background with daytime sky and ground fabric that would look like snow!!! Normally whatever you would use for a class. As we progress with this, we might even want to have a Saturday workshop at some later date.

This is a folk-art quilt; we loved making ours and we want you to have a good time with this.

Sondra Curtis said she had taken six kids quilts to Hospice House.

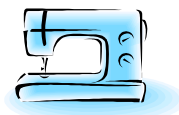
Program: Charlotte Williams gave an

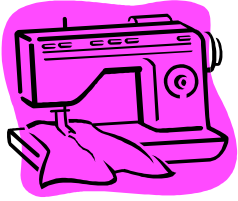

Directions to Benton Senior Adult Center

FROM LITTLE ROCK ON I-30 WEST

Take I-30 West to Benton. Take Exit #116. Go over the overpass onto West south. Go .3 mi. Turn right on Jefferson. Go .1 mi. The Senior Adult Center is on the left.

FROM TEXARKANA ON I-30 EAST

Take I-30 East toward Little Rock. Take Exit #116 toward downtown Benton. Bear to the right onto West South. Go .3 mi. Turn right on Jefferson. Go .1 mi. The Senior Adult Center is on the left.
