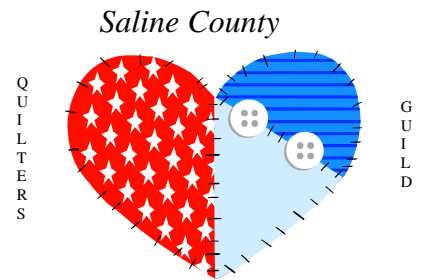

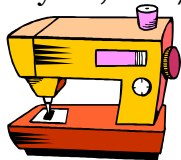
The meeting adjourned at 7:50 .
