Library Report: Memory Quilts In The Making, compiled and edited by Rhonda Richards, is a very interesting book. If the numerous pictures of memory projects won't hook you, then the variety of projects and the stories that go with them will. The book includes chapters on Signature Quilts, Handkerchief and Memorabilia Quilts, T-Shirt Quilts, Photo Transfer Quilts, among others. Patterns and instructions are provided for using Jacob's Ladder, Sister's Choice, fan, and nine patch blocks in memory quilts. The final chapter, titled *In the Sewing Room*, provides quick instructions for all those little details of quilt-making, such as tools needed, making and using templates, the different methods of applique, signing blocks, joining blocks, borders, bindings, and quilt labels. If you would like to know more about this book, I will be glad to help you CHECK IT OUT.
