~ Library Report ~

Library Report: This month, I've revisited one of my favorite books in our library - The Seminole Patchwork Book by Cheryl Greider Bradkin. The author was introduced to Seminole patchwork by some clothing her mother purchased from Florida Indians in 1941. Bradkin used her mother's collection of ethnic clothing to study (in detail) the order, colors, and techniques involved with this style of piecing. There are over 60 Seminole designs in this book, and Bradkin explains that by varying the number and widths of strips, the angles and offsets of pieces, an unlimited number of variations can be sewn. She tells us that even our mistakes can be fascinating, that working with a mishap can lead to a totally beautiful result! It's difficult to explain Seminole patchwork techniques in this small space, so I encourage you to take a look at how it can be used to enhance towels, tote bags, bookcovers, placemats, and various items of clothing. I can help you CHECK IT OUT.
