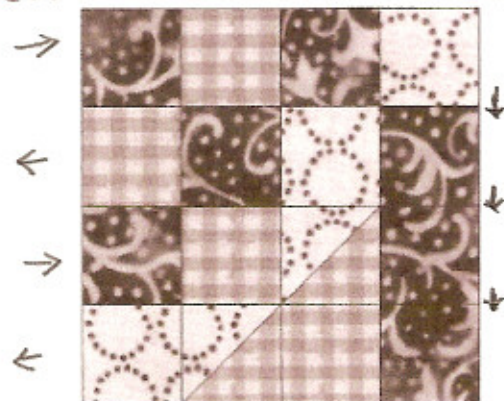

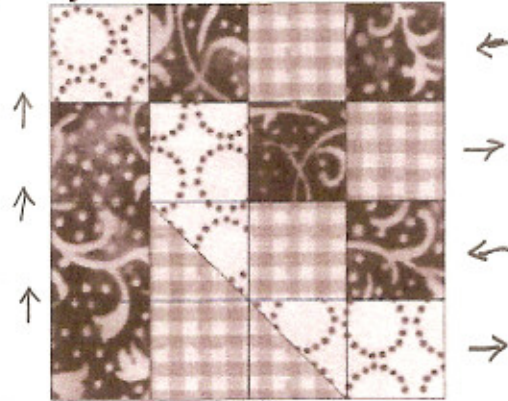
Block 2 - Make Two

Block 2 Flipped- make Two

From Background Fabric cut 12 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (2") squares and 4 - $3\frac{7}{8}$ " ($2\frac{3}{8}$ ") squares .

From Fabric A cut 16 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (2") squares and 4 - $3\frac{7}{8}$ " ($2\frac{3}{8}$ ") squares .

From Fabric B cut 28 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (2") squares

Note: 6" block measurements are in ()

If you like, you can strip piece rows one and two by using 15" (9") strips. You will need to cut 4 strips from each strip-set (one for each block).

Using $3\frac{7}{8}$ " ($2\frac{3}{8}$ ") squares of BG fabric and fabric A make 8 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (2") half square triangles.

Arrange squares and half square triangles into rows as shown in blocks above. Sew rows together. Make two of each block. Label blocks.
