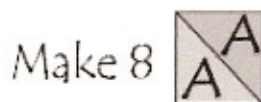
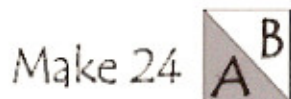

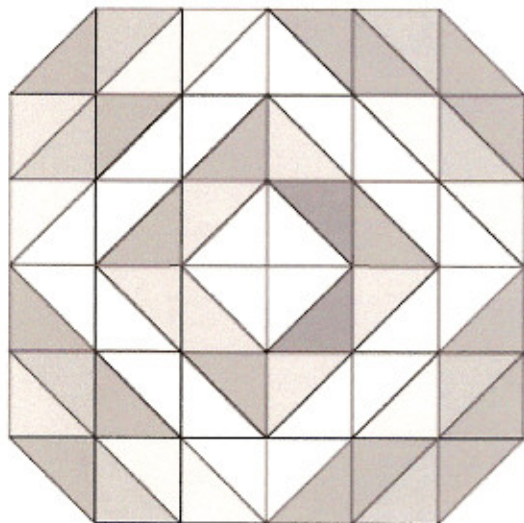
- ☆ ----- ☆
- Fabric Requirements & Cutting:
- From assorted colored fabrics cut:  
 A (22) 5-7/8" squares, cut ONCE diagonally
- From a light FQ cut:  
 D (12) 5-7/8" squares, cut ONCE diagonally
- Wool scraps for bunny:  
 pink, plaid, green, yellow, purple, navy blue, dark pink
- Backing: 22" square  
 Batting: 22" square  
 Binding: 2-1/4" x 85"
- Fusible web - 1yd.  
 Embroidery Floss or wool thread for applique  
 Use 1/4" seam!
- ☆ Paper Scissors ----- ☆  
 ☆ General Sewing Supplies ☆

Scrap sizes for appliqué: Bunny- FQ; Bunny accent-11 x 6; Flowers-4x4 for each; flower centers-1 1/2 x 2 1/2; Nose- 1x1; Stems 8 x 6 or 2, 1/4 " x 9" bias pieces

1- Following the diagrams below, randomly sew the A and D triangles together in these combinations:



2-Arrange to make block as shown:



3- Using fusible web, trace and prepare the applique pieces. The images have already been reversed for tracing.

4- Referring to the photo, lay out the wool pieces. Fuse in place.

5-Using matching thread, blanket stitch around the wool pieces. Use black thread and a stem stitch for the whiskers and face.

6- Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt and bind.
