

Santa Sacks

Supplies

Fabric cut 15" X 17 1/2"

White felt/fake fur cut 2 1/2" X 15"

Fusible

Muslin

1 red pompom

ribbon

2 bells

black paint

hot glue

Instructions

All seams are 1/2"

1. Turn 15" edge under 1/2" and sew close to raw edge. This forms casing for ribbon.
2. Measure down 7" from top edge and place fur trim. Do NOT adhere at this point.
3. Trace face pattern onto fusible, cut out and place top edge under hat trim, centered on each side. Fuse down hat trim and face.
4. Fold fabric right sides together and sew side and bottom seams. Measure down 1 1/4" from point on side seams and sew straight across to make box bottom. Turn right sides out.
5. Using torn fabric strips, tie loose knot in strips and hot glue to face for beard. You can also use yarn, clean mop, etc. Hot glue beard pieces so they cover edges of face. Paint two black dots for eyes. You can use buttons, wiggle eyes, etc. Hot glue red pompom for nose.
6. Using seam ripper, make 2 small slits near back seam at the top. Run ribbon through casing. Tie a bell at each end of ribbon.

These fit nicely over 2 liter soda bottles.
