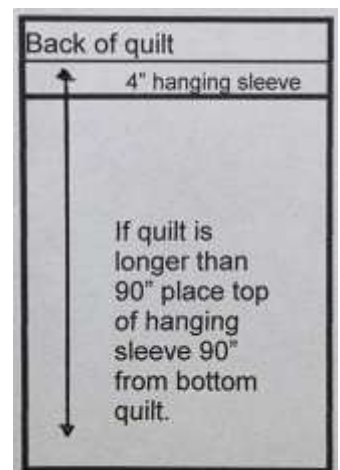
Heart of Arkansas Quilt Show



QUILT REGISTRATION must be received no later than Saturday, July 15, 2027. Priority will be given to members between now and April 15, 2027. Quilt registration will be open to non-members after April 15, 2027. Entry form and check may be mailed to Paula Duncan, 6423 Bailey Cutoff, Benton, AR 72019 or handed in at any guild meeting between now and July 15, 2027. ***Quilts entered are only accepted if they have NEVER been entered into a SCQG show in the past!***

GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES:

1. Fees should be paid by check, made payable to Saline County Quilters' Guild and must accompany registration forms. If there are multiple entries, you may submit one check for the total. Entry fees for entries that are disqualified or not delivered are non-refundable.
 - * **Members:** First entry \$10; additional entries - \$5 each (There is no limit to number of entries but they will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Space may be limited).
 - * **Non-Members:** First Entry \$15; additional entries \$10 each
 - * **Junior Entry:** No fees
2. Each entry must be in its own bag with identification label attached to the outside of the bag. A pillow case is recommended.
3. In addition, each entry must have an identification label securely attached to the back stating your name, address and phone number. To ensure impartiality, please cover your entire identification label with plain paper or cloth, safety pinned or stitched, across the top of the label.
4. Quilts must be brought to Bishop Park in Bryant (6401 Boone Rd., Bryant, AR 72022) (take elevator to 2nd floor Purple Room) on **September 28, 2027** between 8:00 am – 1:00 pm. If you cannot make this timeframe, please drop off your quilts to Cindy Barszczewski at her home, 3417 Britton, Benton, AR 72019 on Monday, Sept. 27, 2027. **Please call first 870-543-0035.**
5. Quilts may be picked up at the Bishop Park in Bryant after 4:00 pm on October 2, 2027. *You must wait until quilts are taken down and organized.* If unable to pick up your own quilt you must designate ON THE REGISTRATION FORM someone else who is authorized to handle your quilt.
6. There must be a 4" hanging sleeve on ALL QUILTS REGARDLESS OF SIZE. It can be safety-pinned, temporarily basted or permanently stitched. If your quilt is longer than 90", place the hanging sleeve 90" from the bottom of the quilt. If there is no hanging sleeve on your quilt, it will not be hung.
7. Your entry must not have been in previous SCQG shows.
8. If known, all persons involved in making the entry should be listed on the registration form.
9. If not an original design, please credit the designer, magazine, book, class, etc.
10. Precautions will be taken to maintain a safe environment for the articles entered, but neither the SCQG nor City of Bryant Bishop Park nor Illine Smith household will be responsible for the loss or damage of any article. Insurance is the responsibility of the owner.
11. Quilts made from convenience fabric or "cheater cloth" will not be accepted.
12. All entries must be quilted by hand, machine, or a combination of the two and must consist of 3 layers: top, batting and back. **EXCEPTION:** Entries in Other Techniques or Art Categories.
13. Each quilt must be constructed and quilted by the person(s) named on the registration form.
14. Quilt may be offered for sale. Please indicate price on registration form. SCQG will charge a 10% fee for quilts sold during the show. Any quilt sold during the show must remain on display until the end of the show.
15. Entries are handled with great care. We ask that all entrants sign the statement at the end of the registration form as evidence of their recognition and assumption of risks as part of the entry form.



CATEGORY DEFINITIONS:

Please look at the category requirements carefully. Size restrictions are specified in the category description (and are listed by total perimeter). While a quilt may meet the requirements of more than one category, please make your decision based on the main element you want judged. Enter the letter representing your category selection on the form below.

- A. Extra Large Quilts, Pieced: 81" wide or wider (320" or more perimeter)
- B. Extra Large Quilts, Appliqued: 81" wide or wider (320" or more perimeter)
- C. Large Quilts, Pieced: 69" - 81" wide (260" - 319" perimeter)
- D. Large Quilts, Appliqued: 69" - 81" wide (260" - 319" perimeter)
- E. Medium Quilts, Pieced: 44" - 68" wide (181" - 259" perimeter)
- F. Medium Quilts, Appliqued: 44" - 68" wide (181" - 259" perimeter)
- G. Small Quilts, Pieced: Under 43" wide (no larger than 189" perimeter)
- H. Small Quilts, Appliqued: Under 43" wide (no larger than 189" perimeter)
- I. Machine Driven Embroidery: Any size
- J. Miniature: Miniature in scale. Interior blocks 4" or less. Quilting is to scale. 24" x 24" or less (80" or smaller perimeter)
- K. Other Techniques – Quilt is constructed of both hand and machine techniques, incorporates one or more elements which do not fit the guidelines of any other categories, i.e. stenciling, whole cloth, yo-yo, cathedral window, crazy quilt, photo transfer, embroidery. Any size.
- L. Miscellaneous – Items that aren't quilts and will be judged on their own merits of workmanship: clothes, bags, purses, quilted crafted, etc.
- M. Scrap – Top must be composed of at least 70 **DIFFERENT** fabrics. Can be pieced or appliqued. Any size.
- N. First Time – The quilter has never entered a formal quilt show (1 entry per person).
- O. Juniors – Quilt top must be made by child under the age of 18. Any construction or quilting technique. Limited adult help is acceptable. Any size:
- P. Art Quilt – Must be entrant's **ORIGINAL DESIGN!** Incorporates the use of one or more of the following: creative concepts, colors, fabrics, surface embellishments, pictorial imagery, abstract design, or landscape scenery. Any size.
